

ASA criteria for assessing an ASA Scholarship application

- Applicant must be an individual financial member of ASA
- Degree of professionalism with which the application form has been completed
- How complete and thorough is the information contained within the application form – does it give the reviewers a good sense of how the scholarship money will be used
- Is the intent of scholarship use directly related to aero-medicine
- How will the scholarship contribute to career progression of the applicant
- How will use of the scholarship contribute to the aeromedical industry
- Applicant's willingness to provide feedback e.g. written report to be published on the ASA website, poster presentation at an ASA conference, oral presentation or hotspot at an ASA conference.
